Tasks

This role involves supporting and assisting our education staff, education program artists and participating students, and teacher.

Specifically the role will involve:

- Assisting with the facilitation of a morning and/or afternoon artist's workshop each day, including the preparation of workshop space and materials, and clean-up of the space at the conclusion of each session;
- Providing assistance to staff and artists before, during and after workshops;
- General assistance with the students to make their excursion as enjoyable as possible

- Enjoyment of working with children; and
- Enthusiastic, well presented and friendly.
