1 STUDENT WORKSHOPS IN SCHOOLS

- \$600 per 60 – 90 minute workshop [minimum of 2 per day]
- 30 students per workshop

2 STUDENT WORKSHOPS ONLINE

Students meet and work with an Artist and actively explore material, themes and sculpture making skills based on the artists' ideas, processes, and creative practice, closely linked with the NSW Education Curriculum for Primary and Secondary students.

Artists who have exhibited in Sculpture by the Sea and educators facilitate an informative, stimulating, and multi-sensory sculpture making workshop virtually.

The program has been adapted to allow students and teachers to meet and work with an Artist and actively explore material, themes and sculpture making skills based on the artists' ideas, processes, and creative practice, closely linked with the NSW Education Curriculum for Primary and Secondary students. Each workshop will require the school to collect a list of materials for the students to create with.

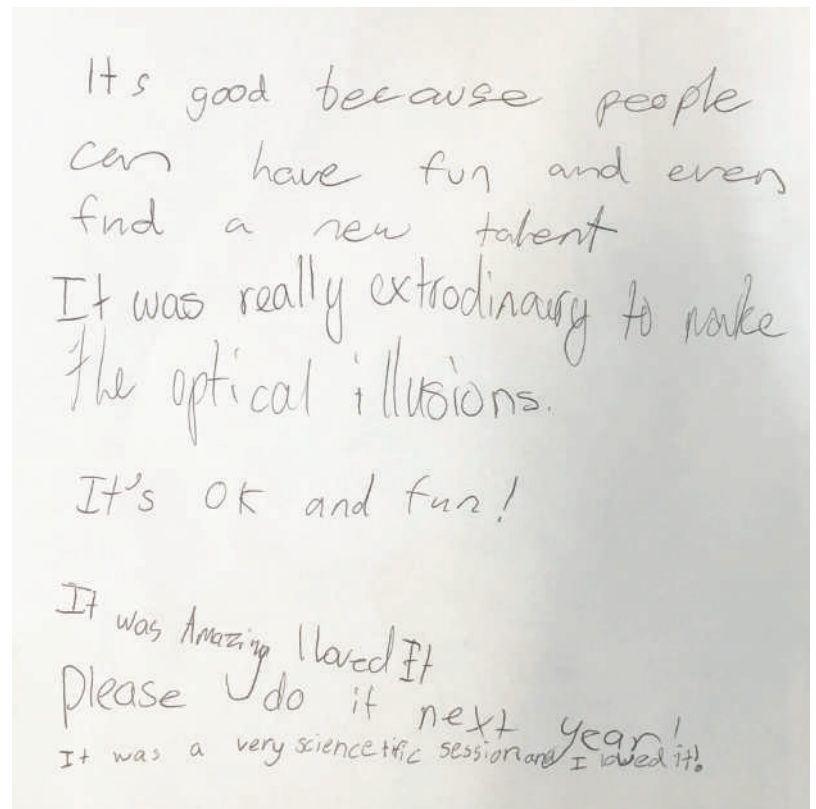

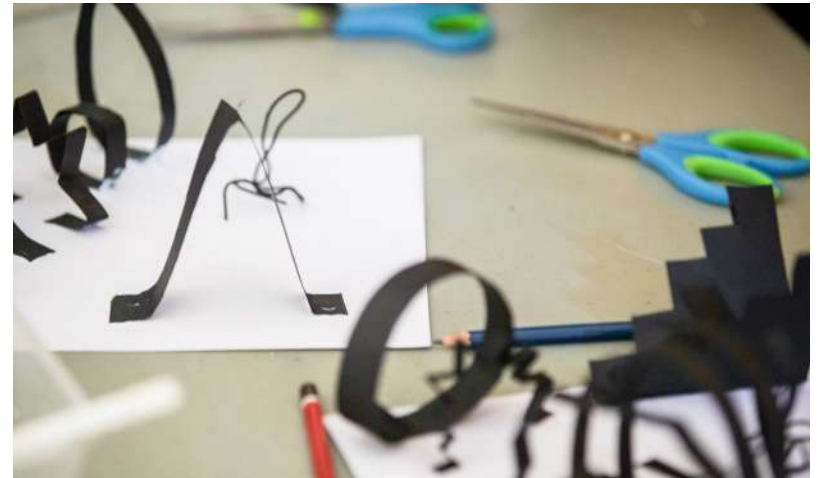
6 WEEK PROGRAM

Delving in greater detail into the artist's practice and processes, this expanded program reinforces learning experiences and provides a valuable, in-depth experience with an artist in residence at the school, including the production of a collaborative, large scale sculpture with students and an exhibition of the residency on the school premises.

- Integrated approach to STEAM and cross-disciplinary critical thinking

WORKSHOPS FOR EDUCATORS

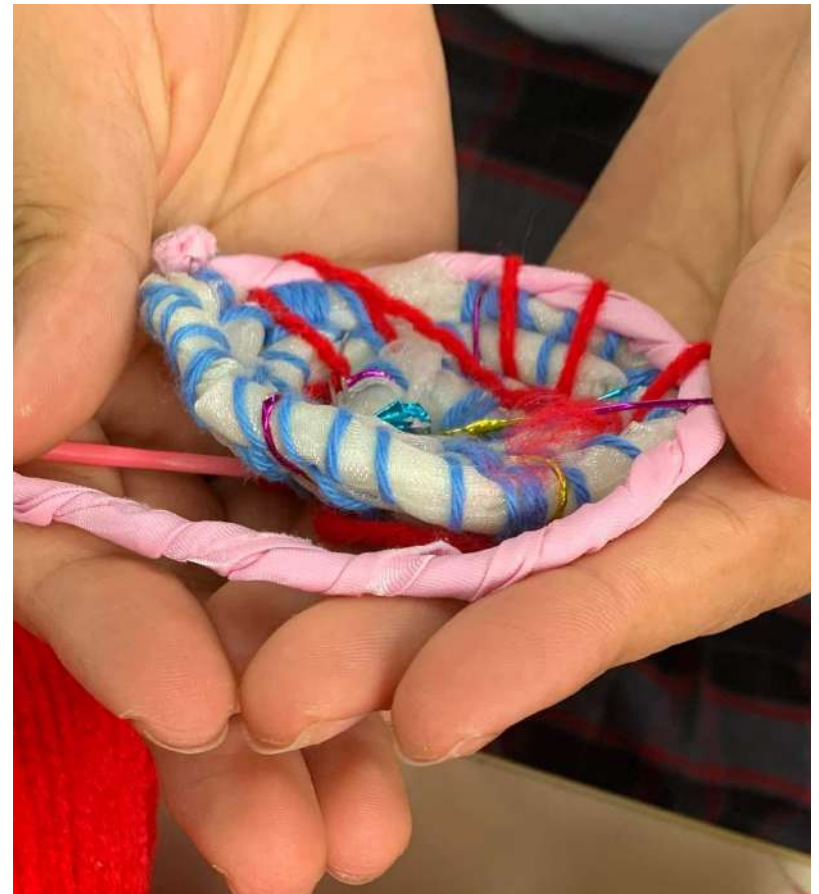
