

Sculpture by the Sea, Bondi 2022 Allens People's Choice Prize

Terms & Conditions

1. Participation

The Sculpture by the Sea, Bondi 2022 Allens People's Choice Prize competition (the Competition) is conducted by Sculpture by the Sea Incorporated, Suite 302, 61 Marlborough Street, Surry Hills, NSW (the Promoter). Entry to the Competition constitutes acceptance of these conditions. The Competition is only open to an individual who: (a) is a resident of Australia aged 18 years or older; (b) has visited Sculpture by the Sea, Bondi 2022; (c) is not an employee of the Promoter or agencies and companies associated with the Competition; and (c) is not an immediate relative of such an employee.

2. How to vote & enter

There are four methods of entering the competition:

(a) **In Person:** fill out a People's Choice Prize voting form and put it into the box at the Competition location (Bondi);

(b) **Online:** fill out an online People's Choice Prize voting form at www.sculpturebythesea.com/bondi/vote;

(c) **Sculpture by the Sea App:** make a gallery of your favourite sculptures within the new Sculpture by the Sea app and vote in-app; and

(d) **QR Code:** scan the QR Code located on the Allens People's Choice onsite signage, within the exhibition catalogue p95, or on paper voting forms which will direct you to the online voting form.

Entries must be submitted between midnight 20 October 2022 and 12 noon 6 November 2022 (AEST) (the Competition Period). By making an Entry, entrants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. Multiple entries will be permitted.

3. People's Choice Award

The artist who receives the most votes for their sculpture will be awarded \$5,000; announced 6 November at 2pm.

4. Voter's Prize

Three entries will be randomly drawn from each method of entry as above 2. (a), (b) and (c) will win a Sculpture by the Sea Prize Pack, valued at \$500. All entries to the Competition are subject to verification by the Promoter. An entrant must provide to the Promoter copies of documents requested to establish eligibility, including proof of age. If an Entry is ineligible or the entrant is not able to accept a prize, a new Entry will be drawn. Three winners will be given prizes (one from each method of entry). Winners will be notified in writing and/or by phone within 7 days of the Competition Period. Prizes can be collected, otherwise they will be sent by mail (to Australian

addresses only). If any prize (or part of any prize) is unavailable, the Promoter, in its discretion, reserves the right to substitute the prize (or that part of the prize) with a prize of approximately equal value. All decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

5. Entries

Every Entry becomes the property of the Promoter. Entries will be used by the Promoter to support the winner's claim to the prize so that the Promoter can provide the prize to the winner and verify their identity.

6. Privacy

Entrants' personal information will be kept confidential and will not be provided to third parties without prior consent, however by entering into the competition the entrant gives the Promoter permission to de-identify the information provided to develop and share quantitative data about the exhibition for use in marketing and promotional materials. Please see our Collection Notice below for more information on how we collect and use your personal information.

7. Limitation of Liability

The Promoter and Allens are not liable for any loss, damage or personal injury in relation to this Competition or the use of the prize.

The Promoter reserves the right to modify, suspend or terminate the competition without notice.

Collection Notice

What information is collected?

Sculpture by the Sea collects your personal contact information, including your name, phone number and email address. We also collect demographic information, including your postcode, employment description, age bracket and the number of children who attended the event with you.

If you win a voter's prize, we will ask you to verify your age.

Purpose for collecting information

We collect your personal contact details so that we can notify you if you have won a voter's prize. If you win a voter's prize, we are required to verify your age to determine if you are eligible to win the prize.

We also collect your contact details so that we can send you our newsletter. You can choose not to receive our newsletter by ticking the appropriate box on the voting form. Otherwise, you can unsubscribe from our newsletter at any time by contacting us.

We collect demographic information from you for the purposes of understanding our audience and considering feedback for future exhibitions we hold. This information is de-identified so it is not traceable back to your name and personal contact details.

Consequence of not providing personal information

If you do not provide us with all relevant information, or if you choose not to identify yourself, you may be ineligible to win a voter's prize.

Disclosure of personal information

We do not share your personal information. However, we may share de-identified analytics data with our sponsors.

We do not share your personal information outside of Australia.
