

Senior Installer/Duty Shift Manager

Sculpture by the Sea, Bondi 2023

Job Description

Sculpture by the Sea is an internationally recognised free to the public, annual exhibition held along the coastal walk between Bondi and Tamarama. Our Senior Installers/Duty Shift Managers report directly to the Site Managers and are primarily:

- Responsible for preparing the exhibition site;
- Leading a small team for the installation of a variety of sculpture;
- Overseeing and managing daily exhibition standard operating procedures in collaboration with the Site Crew;
- Conducting maintenance as necessary of the sculptures during the exhibition;
- Leading a small team for the de-installation of a variety of sculpture; and,
- Monitoring risk and responding to incidents at all times onsite.

General Tasks

- Be available for all days including: Induction (Saturday 14 October); Installation (Monday 16 to Thursday 19 October), Exhibition as per roster (Friday 20 October to Monday 6 November); and De-installation (Tuesday 7 to Friday 10 November).
- Pre-installation dates can be discussed (Monday 9 to Friday 13 October);
- Be available for all days of the exhibition period including weekends with up to 6 shifts per week as rostered;
- Work under the direction of the Site Manager, and other Sculpture by the Sea staff to run the day to day operations of the event;
- Work with artists and site curators for the erection/assembly of sculptures and site structures during installation/de installation many of which are complex installations of unique artworks in a public area;
- Provide a presence on site;
- To assist with the maintenance / cleaning of the artworks and the site during the exhibition;
- Complete daily reports and exhibition records;
- To interact with other exhibition staff, volunteers and visitors to the exhibition;
- Maintain radio contact during shift periods;
- To work outdoors, meet new people and have fun in the process!

Essential Criteria

- Excellent verbal communication skills;
- Management of teams engaged in complex installations of unique artworks in a public area;
- An appreciation for the arts and artists;
- The ability to work under considerable pressure especially during installation periods;
- An energetic, hands on, enjoy working outdoors attitude understanding that “the show must go on”;
- Current First Aid Certificate (HLTAID011);
- A valid C class Australian drivers license.

Desired Criteria

- A valid telehandler (NSW Gold Card) and/or EWP (NSW Yellow Card) license;
- A practical and technical skills background is highly desirable;
- Manual labour/ building/ construction experience is highly desirable;
- Good communication skills and a strong team ethic;
- Experience in the arts and event management is desirable, but not necessary;
- Knowledge of materials and fabrication processes
