Job Description

Sculpture by the Sea is an internationally recognised free to the public, annual exhibition held along the coastal walk between Bondi and Tamarama. Our Site Crew are responsible for preparing the site, the installation of artworks in the lead up to the exhibition, the maintenance of the works during and the de-installation of the works at the end of the exhibition.

Tasks

- Be available for installation including; Induction (Saturday 11 October - Marks Park Tamarama @ 8.00am) ; Installation (Monday 13 to Thursday 16 October), Exhibition as per roster (Friday 17 October to Monday 3 November); and De-installation (Tuesday 4 to Friday 7 November).
- Pre-installation dates can be discussed (Monday 7 to Friday 10 October);
- Be available for all days of the exhibition including weekend shifts (up to 6 days per week as rostered);
- Work under the direction of the Site & Logistics Manager, and other Sculpture by the Sea staff to run the day to day operations of the event;
- Assist with the bump-in/-out of event infrastructure;
- Assist with the complex installations of unique artworks in a public area;
- Provide a presence on site;
- To assist with the maintenance of the works and the site during the exhibition;
- Complete daily reports and exhibition records;
- To interact with other exhibition staff, volunteers and visitors to the exhibition;
- Maintain radio contact during shift periods.

Desired Skills

- Energetic, hands on, enjoy working outdoors and understand the term "the show must go on";
- White Card essential;
- A practical and technical skills background is desirable;
- Manual labour/ building/ construction experience is desirable, but not necessary.
- Good communication skills and a strong team ethic;
- Experience in the arts and event management is desirable, but not necessary;
- Current drivers license is desirable, but not necessary.
